## L.I. 881-WILDLIFE RESERVES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred on the chairman of the National Redemption Council by section 11 of the Wild Animals Preservation Act 1961 (Act 43), these Regulations are made this $14^{\text {th }}$ day of May, 1974.

Establishment 1. There is hereby established a Reserve to be known as the Bia National Park, of reserves and accordingly, immediately after paragraph of regulation 1 of the Wildlife Reserves Regulation, 1971 (L.I. 710) there is hereby inserted the following
"(g) Bia National Park"

## BIA NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Bia National Park is situated in the Western Region and lies between Latitudes $6^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ and $6^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ North and Longitudes $2^{\circ} 55^{\prime}$ and $3^{\circ} 15^{\prime}$ West. Boundary pillar no. 1 is situated at the hunting camp Konkunso which is about $31 / 2$ miles along the path running south-east from Debisso through Samakro. From B.P. 1 the boundary runs on a bearing $124^{\circ}$ for a distance of 170 chains passing through B.P. 2 to 5 to B.P. 6; thence on a bearing of $161^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 170 chains passing through B.Ps. 7 to 10 to B.P. 11; thence on a bearing of $183^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 595 chains passing through B.Ps. 12 to 25 to B.P. 26; thence on a bearing of $151^{\circ}$ for a distance of 660 chains passing through B.P. 27 to 42 to B.P.43, thence on a bearing of $246^{\circ}$ for a distance of 211 chains passing through B.Ps. 44 to 48 to B.P.49; thence on a bearing of $321^{\circ}$ for a distance of 220 chains passing through B.P. 50 to 55 to B.P. 56 , thence on a bearing of $309^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 478 chains passing through B.P. 57 to 67 to B.P. 68 , thence on a bearing of $264^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 475 chains passing through B.Ps. 69 to 79 to B.P. 80 ; thence on a bearing of $32^{\circ}$ for a distance of 515 chains passing through B.P. 81 to 92 to B.P. 93 ; thence on a bearing of $19^{\circ}$ for a distance of 400 chains passing through B.P. 94 to 102 to B.P. 103; thence on a bearing of $135^{\circ}$ $30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 93.6 chains passing through B.P. 104 to 105 to B.P. 106; thence on a bearing of $60^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 371.55 chains passing through B.P. 107 to 115 to B.P. 1 which is the point of commencement.

All bearings are approximate and refer to true north.
All distances are more or less.
