The Role

The position reports to the various District Managers and the incumbent role is to provide operational support for the achievement of the Divisions objectives

Key Responsibilities

- Responsible for the administration of the Range
- Collect and analyse data for the preparation of Management Plans
- Implement prescriptions outlined in the Management Plans within the Range
- Collect data for the award of Timber Felling Rights and capture data on timber harvesting
- Represent the District Manager at the meetings of MDA's and Traditional Authorities among others
- Investigate forest offences within the Range
- Submit regular reports on forestry activities within the Range
- Undertake regular reports on forestry activities within the Range
- Undertake plantation activities within the Range in line with the Forest Plantation Strategy
